THREE TIPS FOR HAVING FUN

Learning can be fun, whether it's about golf or a new subject at school. Here are three tips you can use to get more fun out of learning.

- **Be Patient:** Stay calm while you are learning and give yourself lots of chances to succeed.
- **Be Positive:** Enjoy what you are doing regardless of the outcome.
- **Ask for Help:** You can learn from others, but only if you let them to give you a hand.

GOLF RULE

Rule 13.2 Leaving the flagstick in when putting

- There is no longer a penalty if a ball played from the putting green hits a flagstick left in the hole.
- Players are not required to putt with the flagstick in the hole; rather, they continue to have the choice to have it removed (which includes having someone attend the flagstick and remove it after the ball is played).

GOLF SKILL

Your putter face needs to be pointing at your target when you strike the ball. Lay down two clubs and make a bowling alley just a little wider than your putter head. Hit 5 putts and see if you can roll the ball down the middle of the alley without the putter or the ball hitting the rails you made with the clubs.

PUTTING GAME: MEASURE YOUR SKILL



Your putter should be lined up directly at your target when your putter strikes the ball. To check this, we can use a measuring tape.

- Pull out the measuring tape to 8 feet and lock the tape in place.
- Put your ball on the tape at the end and see if you can get the ball to roll all the way down the tape without falling off.
- Being careful, stretch the tape out a few more feet and putt again, seeing if you can keep it on the tape.
- Repeat the drill until you have stretched out the tape measure as far as it will go.
